Units

Quarter I: Greek and Roman Unit, basic theory review – basic theory through diatonic scales

Quarter II: Baroque Period, Chords: I, IV, V

Quarter III: Classical Period, score analysis, composition

Quarter IV: Romantic Period, score analysis, composition
