This year you will continue the immersion French program. We will be using **CAMPUS 1 and 2**, an audiovisual methodology entirely in French.

After completing this year, here are some examples of what you will know to properly communicate in French the following situations:

- Present your resume
- Understand and tell an anecdote
- Talk about your passions and hobbies
- Behaviour and relations between young people
- Environment and development
- Psychological description of people
- Art (Magritte, Monet)
- Economy and enterprises
- Conjugate and use the main tenses: present, past, future, conditional, passive form, subjunctive, pluperfect, past participle, gerund, simple past (passé simple).
- Defend your opinion.
- Discover the truth (present information, express possibilities and probabilities, present the circumstances of an event...)
- Understand the world.
- Build the future.

In addition to closely following **CAMPUS** we will be studying:

- **Poetry:** Prévert, Apollinaire, Victor Hugo, Tardieu, Maurice Carême, Paul Fort ...
- **French literature:** Pagnol, Victor Hugo...
- **Songs** by several wonderful French singers.
- Articles from **prominent French newspapers and magazines**, such as “Le Monde, Le Monde Diplomatique, Le Nouvel Observateur, Le Point, L’Express”.
- Beginning skills for **translation**.

When choosing the teaching material, I wanted a textbook that is up-to-date with current events in France, so important to teach appropriate French culture, and that will teach you the French standards that are set worldwide by the French Department of Education.

My goal for this coming year is to make this class interesting and informative enough, so that you want to successfully continue learning French in the coming years of your life.
