

TEACHER'S AIDE

General

A Teacher's Aide supports the educational program in the classroom but does not represent the school in any official capacity. He or she may teach the students at the direction of the classroom teacher or Principal and reports to the School's Assistant Principal. All teachers' aides are expected to:

- support and supplement the educational program in the classroom
- work under the teacher's direction
- research and gather resources and materials needed for lesson units
- teach the virtues necessary to live in a democratic society in an appropriate and sanctioned manner
- contribute to the moral and intellectual environment of the school
- work effectively with faculty and other staff as a team to improve the students' education

Minimum Job Requirements

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Demonstrated competence in reading, writing, and math

Desired Job Characteristics

- Bachelor's degree
